Outside Areas located within City/Town limits must obtain written approval from that jurisdiction.

NOTE: Once the Outside Area has been approved, you must obtain a Final Compliance Inspection BEFORE you open and serve alcoholic beverages in that area.

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REQUIREMENTS FOR PERMANANT/SEASONAL OUTSIDE SERVICE

- **No service** of alcohol can take place on an outside deck or patio area unless **PRIOR** Board approval has been requested and granted.
- The area for which outside service is requested must be attached to the licensed premises (building) in some manner.
- **All applicable permits** must be approved and obtained from all required agencies (i.e., Health Department, Planning & Zoning, Fire Marshal, etc.). This is the responsibility of the Licensee/Applicant. **Final Approval from the Harford County Liquor Control Board is contingent upon the fulfillment of ALL requirements for additions to the licensed premises.**
- Outside/Seasonal service of alcoholic beverages is a *privilege* granted by the Harford County Liquor Control Board. This privilege can be suspended or revoked by the Board for violations of the alcoholic beverage laws.
- **To apply for/request permission for alcohol service** in/on an outside area of the licensed premises, the following must be completed:
 - (1) The ***Outside Service Area Application*** must be completed, including the **Landlord's signature**.
 - (2) A written plan must be submitted, including, but not limited to, the following:
 - (a) A detailed description of the exact area to be utilized for outside service, the times for service, and the stationary and/or moveable structure to be used for containment of the area of service.
***Roping or tape is not an acceptable product for containment.**
 - (b) A diagram illustrating the proposed area for outside service. Photos may also be submitted.
 - (c) Specific information on the type of structure to be used for containment and how the area is to be controlled/monitored.
 - (3) An inspection of the requested service area by the Harford County Liquor Control Board staff may be required prior to final approval of the request.
- Once an approval for outside service is granted, yearly requests are not required UNLESS there is a change in the service area or monitoring.
