Mrs. Powell reported that the hearing for Harbor Wine & Spirits is scheduled for June 9, 2021; Chair Tilley will speak with Mr. Foulk regarding a venue.

Mrs. Powell reported that there is at least one Supplemental Application that will not be filed and processed in time to go before the Board next week. In the past, the Board could extend the license for 10 days to accommodate this, but an extension might not be necessary under the Executive Order; Mrs. Finneran will research the issue.

Mrs. Finneran advised that the AG's office has not yet responded to our request regarding the residency issue and suspects that their reply will come directly to the HCLCB address.

Inspector Colburn reported that the second compliance test for the year was recently conducted; fifteen establishment were tested, and five establishments served the underage cadet. The Inspector intends to conduct a total of six compliance tests this year.

There being no further business, motion was made and duly seconded to adjourn the meeting.
