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## RESPONSIBILITIES & REGULATIONS FOR HOLDERS OF A FIRE DEPARTMENT MULTIPLE EVENT LICENSE

All persons or fire departments using the Fire Department Multiple Event License as authorized by the Alcoholic Beverages (AB) Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland (§ 22-1311) and the Rules & Regulations of the Harford County Liquor Control Board are subject to the laws pertaining to the sale, consumption and possession of alcoholic beverages. Fire Department entertainment events are subject to inspections by the Harford County Liquor Control Board, Health Department, and Fire Marshal's Office.

- Application must be made by at least 2 individuals affiliated in an official capacity with the fire department. Individuals who may apply include officers of the company; or a social event coordinator or hall manager duly authorized by the fire department to act on its behalf. One of the license holders must be present during the entire event. The Board will hold all license holders responsible for any violation of the laws pertaining to the sale, consumption, and possession of alcoholic beverages at the event.
- The holder of a Fire Department Multiple Event License may sell or provide beer and wine for on-premises
  consumption at an entertainment event held by the fire department; or by a person who has rented or leased an
  area of the licensed premises for an event and guests who attend the event.
- The license holder shall either **contract to provide**, or otherwise ensure that **adequate food will be available** for consumption at the event in conjunction with the sale of alcoholic beverages, based on the capacity of the event.
- The holder of a Fire Department Multiple Event License may purchase beverages from a wholesaler, beer distributor, or retailer.
- The Fire Department Multiple Event License must be prominently displayed in a conspicuous location near where the alcohol is being dispensed during the event.
- All sales must cease by 2:00 a.m.; no alcohol can be consumed after 2:15 a.m.; and all alcoholic beverage containers must be cleared by 2:30 a.m.
- License holders and volunteers/employees for the event **may not consume any alcohol during the event**. Persons who appear to be intoxicated cannot be served.
- A license holder may not permit any person to drink alcoholic beverages not purchased from the license holder on the premises.
- For the consumption, possession, or purchase of alcoholic beverages, a person must be 21 years of age. License holders are responsible for age verification.
- No premises may be used for the purpose of bookmaking or gambling in any form, except when specifically authorized by law.

(Continued)

- No license holder, agent, or employee shall commit or allow the commission on the licensed premises any act which
  is contrary to the federal, state, or local statues, laws, or ordinances, or against the public peace, safety, health, or
  welfare.
- Alcoholic beverages can only be consumed in the area described as the licensed premises.
- For **events held outside, an Outside Event application** (available at <u>www.hclcb.org</u>) must be completed and submitted to the Board for approval.

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
